## **Investment update - December**

Markets in December continued to rally after the partial removal of two important issues; the UK's political uncertainty and Brexit (thanks to a convincing Conservative win), and the de-escalation of the US/China trade war. Although there are still many hurdles to overcome in the UK/EU negotiation process, a clearer path should allow a re -boot of business investment and spending, allowing disenchanted investors to return and potentially unlocking economic growth further down the line. Low inflation and the stable interest rate environment in general may also provide a more favourable backdrop for investment in risk assets. As such, our Investment Committee decided to shift away from our previous neutral stockmarket stance by adding 5% to UK equities, taking the Growth strategy's headline equity target to 75%. The Montanaro UK Income fund has been added to the strategy to provide exposure to quality companies in the UK small and mid-cap sectors whilst also having an equity income focus, which should provide additional return support. To enable the purchase of the fund, there has been a reduction in cash levels and there remains the possibility of adding further exposure to equities in the new year if the improved backdrop remains. Although there may be low rates of economic growth forecast for 2020, which may in turn lead to lower nominal returns, we are happy to report strong returns for 2019 with the Growth strategy returning 13.8%.






